DAY 0



 Start your adventurous journey by boarding an evening AC Luxury Coach/Tempo traveler/Sedan car/SUV car (depending on the group size) from Delhi around 8 -9:00 Pm.

DRIVE TO DEVPRAYAG -RUDRAPRAYAG - GUPTKASHI

- Visit Har ki Paudi early in the morning at Haridwar and experience the mesmerizing and enchanting early morning Ganga aarti, depending on time and head towards Devprayag.
- Have breakfast (ON YOUR OWN).
- Proceed towards Guptkashi, On the way take a short stopover at Devprayag where you can witness the Holy Sangam of Bhagirathi and Alaknanda that together form Ganga.
- After this, you'll get back on the way to Guptkashi witnessing some of the most beautiful landscapes.
- On reaching Guptkashi / sitapur, check-in into the Hotel. Overnight stay at Guptkashi / Sitapur.

TREK TO KEDARNATH

- Wake up early and have a delicious breakfast at the hotel and then proceed to Sonprayag by road 1.5 km walk.
- Once you reach Sonprayag, walk to the Government Union taxi stand to reach Gaurikund (Walk for 1 Km as no private vehicles are allowed in Gaurikund).
- You can take ponies or palanquins for the journey to make it slightly more comfortable (at own expense).
- Start the trek to Kedarnath from Gaurikund covering beautiful valley and river stream.
- Take a lunch break in between and continue the journey.
- Witness the Kedarnath Temple, situated right at the center of the valley with mountains surrounding it.
- On reaching Kedarnath, you'll witness the whole valley filled with the sound of ringing bells and prayers going on everywhere, which will surely provide relief to your soul.
- Overnight stay in camps/ homestays at Kedarnath.

TREK DOWN FROM KEDARNATH

- Wake up early morning , visit temple for darshan. Post early morning Darshan, have breakfast and start trekking back to Gaurikund from Kedarnath.
 - You can take ponies or palanquins for the journey to make journey more comfortable.
 - Once you reach Gaurikund, proceed to Sonprayag by government Taxi.
 - Arrive at Sonprayag and walk for 1 km to reach the vehicle/ hotel.
 - Dinner and Overnight stay in the hotel in Sitapur/ Guptkashi.

JOURNEY SITAPUR TO BADRINATH TEMPLE

- Wake up & post breakfast, pack your bags and start your journey towards Badrinath Temple.
- After reaching Badrinath Temple, check in to the hotel upon arrival in Badrinath.
- Pilgrims, after having a bath in the Tapt Kund, have the Darshan of Badri Vishal and attend the Aarti in the evening.
- Brahma Kapal is significant for Pind Daan (Shraddh) of ancestors (Pitrus).
- There are other interesting sightseeing spots like: Mana, Vyas Gufa, Maatamoorti, Charanpaduka, Bhimkund, and the "Mukh of the Saraswati River"
- All these are located just within 3 km of Badrinath.

BADRINATH - RISHIKESH - DELHI

- Wake up early and have a delicious breakfast.
- Head towards Rishikesh / haridwar from Badrinath and explore Rishikesh (depends on time).
- Experience the peaceful Ganga vibes and reach Delhi late in the night.
- The trip terminates here with a lifetime of memories and Baba's Blessings.



DAY 5





- Both Side Transportation : From Delhi/ Rishikesh/ Haridwar to Kedarnath. (5D4N including travel time)
- Stays: 3N 4D
- Meals: 3 Breakfasts, 3 Dinners
- Starting from dinner in Guptkashi and ending with breakfast (Basic food will be provided as per the hill culture & trekking needs)
- Every day departure from Delhi (Minimum 6 persons)
- No room sharing is applicable at Kedarnath. Each person will get one bed, one pillow, and one blanket. Stays will be basic as per the remote area.
- Any cost arising due to natural calamities like landslides, roadblocks, etc., to be borne by the customer on the spot.
- Sightseeing depends on your time management and cooperation among your co-passengers.
- Coordinator Assistance
- Tour Guide
- Trekking (The Kedarnath Trek and Yatra Pass)
- Trek with guide to Kedarnath
- As it is a group tour, no stop will be conducted according to all group members' preferences.
- In case the yatra is interrupted during your trip, the company is not liable for arranging any extra expenses, stays, or anything that is not included in your trip plan.

- Lunch
- Snow / Water Activities Charges
- Personal Expenses
- Any cost arising due to Natural calamities like landslides, road blocks etc. (to be borne directly by the customer on the spot)
- Any personal expenses like tip to the Driver, entry to monuments/monasteries, camera /video charges, laundry, telephone bills, tips etc.
- Any kind of food & beverages that is not included in the package like alcohol, mineral water/refreshments etc.
- Anything not mentioned in the inclusions.

CANCELLATION POLICY

No Refund shall be made with respect to the initial booking amount for any cancellations. However,

-> If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

-> If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

-> If cancellations are made within 0-15 days before the start date of the trip, 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

In the case of unforeseen weather conditions or government restrictions, certain activities may be canceled and in such cases, the operator will try his best to provide an alternate feasible activity. However, no refund will be provided for the same.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Booking: All booking for the tours /treks are made with TRAVEXX, hereinafter referred to as 'the company', and are subject to the conditions: the person signing the booking form accepts the conditions and is hereafter referred to as the client.

- The organizers or any individual connected with the camp shall not be held responsible for any accident or any unforeseen natural calamity
- Last moment changes on the program will not be acceptable. The final decision on any dispute will be taken by TRAVEXX.
- Participants are expected to be in discipline. One can be dismissed from the program/camp who is found to be misbehaving with any individual or staff members, without prior notice.
